OPEN CALL FOR ARTISTS

Banfill-Locke Center for the Arts (BLCA) is proud to serve as a significant source for accessible, quality arts experiences in Fridley, the north metro, and Greater Twin Cities area. BLCA is now accepting proposals from artists for 2019-2020 exhibition season.

BLCA offers exhibiting artists support in presenting their art work, including marketing and promotion efforts and installation needs. The work of emerging and established artists and artist groups is selected by a committee of artists, arts enthusiasts, and curators. The committee is especially interested in proposals from artists who have considered the Banfill community and environment. While solo shows are sometimes offered, they are rare and more often artists are paired to present two-person exhibitions.

GUIDLINES

Proposals for exhibition season May 2019 to June 2020 will be accepted January 1 through March 31, 2018. A selection committee will evaluate, rank, and make decisions for the exhibition season and accepted proposals will be notified by June 30, 2018.

Selection Criteria:

- Quality of current work or work in progress.
- Strength and innovation of proposed exhibition

- Title of the project
- 1. Cover Sheet containing the following (one page)
 - Your name, postal address, phone number, and main email.
 - Names of all participating artists if a group or collective
 - Project description – (up to 50 words)

2. Project detail (one page) including why you are choosing Banfill-Locke Center for the Arts as a potential exhibition location. Include a brief outline of the main ideas or concepts that will be explored through this exhibition.

3. Artist resume or curriculum vita. (one page for each artist exhibiting)

4. 6-10 jpeg images labeled as follows:

- Lastname001.jpeg (example: Jones001.jpeg)
- Include an image listing (one page) as follows:

Image number - Title of image – artist name-medium – dimensions

Example:

001 – Winter Night - Rob Jones – Oil on panel – 20”x32”

002 – Summer – Ann Lamont – photograph – 11”x 14”

1. No image resolution greater than 300 dpi
2. Maximum image size of 800 x 600 pixels
